DID YOU KNOW?

You don't always have to come to the library to read books! You can also read and check out audiobooks from home using NetLibrary. NetLibrary is a provider of electronic books and audiobooks that you can access from the Lake Travis Community Library's catalog page. Just login with your library card number and password, and click on the [NetLibrary link](#) or eAudiobooks logo on the catalog home page. Browse the catalog of over 190,000 titles to find the book or audiobook you're looking for. You can read electronic books right on your web browser and navigate the book using contents menu on the left hand side of the page.

For audiobooks, click on the Download this eAudiobook link and choose "Check Out and Download CD Quality." You will then be prompted to create a user account which will be different from your library account information. Feel free to create any user account name and password and keep it handy for future reference. After logging in, the audiobook should begin to download. This file can then be transferred to your portable media player device in the manner similar to any other audio files you transfer on your device. This process will vary from device to device. Please visit the [NetLibrary eAudiobook](#) help links at the bottom of the NetLibrary page with answers to specific questions about various media players and other information. We encourage our tech savvy audiobook listening patrons to give this service a try. Please feel free to contact the library with any questions, concerns, or feedback!
