## New Computer Reservation System

The library recently installed a new computer system that allows patrons to make reservations and to keep track of printing requests. Computer time is limited to one hour, but can be extended if no one is waiting. Patrons may now choose between black and white and color printing. Costs have also changed. Black and white copies continue to be \$.10 per page and color copies cost \$.25 per page. You can also choose to save paper by printing duplex (double-sided). Patrons with laptops can download a print client while in the library to allow use of the library's printer. We will all be getting used to this new system in the coming months, so please ask us if you have any questions!
