Since then, she has published three books about growing up and growing old in Texas and other peculiar things.

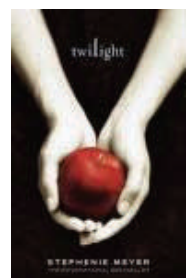
