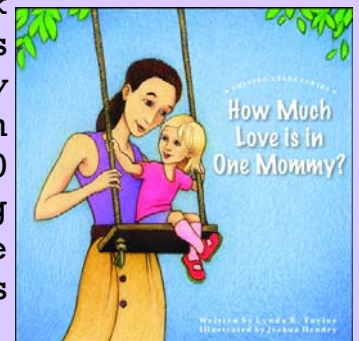

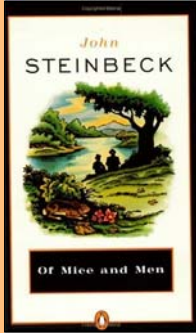

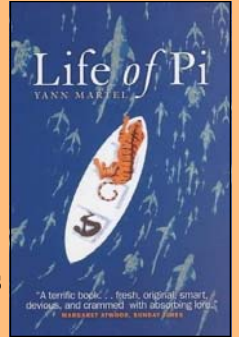
# Pre-AP English Discussion Groups

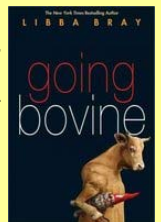

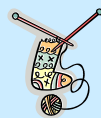
The **Friends Book Club** will take a break in July and August and reconvene the first Tuesday of September.

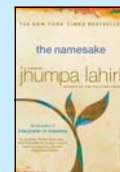
