# HARRY POTTER PARTY SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 14 AT 3 PM

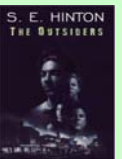

Three to six year olds are invited to attend a class on Thursday, November 11th at 10:30 AM. Yoga instructor Jessica Dixon leads this 30 minute class

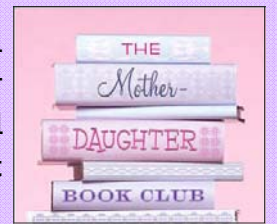


that allows children to experience exercise in a mellow environment. With adult participation, little people will practice breathing and age appropriate stretching. Wear comfortable clothing and let's get moving!

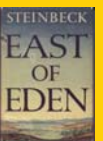
