Author Susan Wittig Albert will speak on Saturday, September 25th at 10:30 AM at TexARTS. In 1985, Susan left her career as a university English professor and administrator and began working full-time as a novelist. Her books include the best-selling China Bayles mysteries, the Cottage Tales of Beatrix Potter, and the Robin Paige Victorian/Edwardian mysteries written with her husband, Bill Albert. Working together, the Alberts have also written over 60 young adult novels. Susan's latest project is a series of historical mysteries, *The Darling Dahlias*, set in the 1930s. The first in the series, *The Darling Dahlias and the Cucumber Tree*, has already received numerous starred reviews.



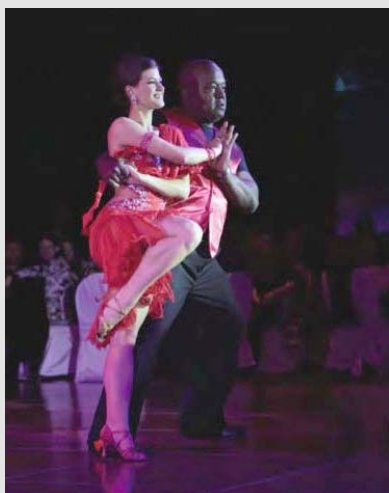
Albert's nonfiction titles include *What Wildness is This: Women Write About the Southwest* (winner of the 2009 Willa Award for Creative Nonfiction); *With Courage and Common Sense*; *Writing from Life*; and *Work of Her Own: A Woman's Guide to Success Off the Career Track*.

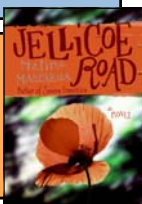

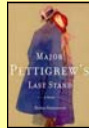

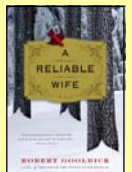
