NEWS ABOUT THE NEW LIBRARY

Lake Travis Community Library is thrilled to announce that we have the deed to the land for the new building! Generous donor Haythem Dawlett and the LTCL Board of Trustees signed the official documents on March 3rd.

On March 11th, the Lakeway City Council voted to hold a bond election to consider authorizing the sale of bonds to finance a building to be constructed on the land donated by Haythem Dawlett. The bond election will be held on Saturday, May 14, 2011. The Library and the City intend to enter into an interlocal agreement under which the Library District will pay the City for the principal and interest on the bonds issued to construct the building. The Library District encourages City of Lakeway residents to vote on May 14th.



BLUEGRASS MUSIC WITH KAREN MILLION

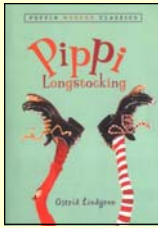
THURSDAY, APRIL 7 @ 7 PM

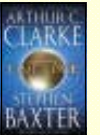

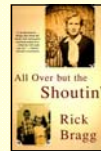
