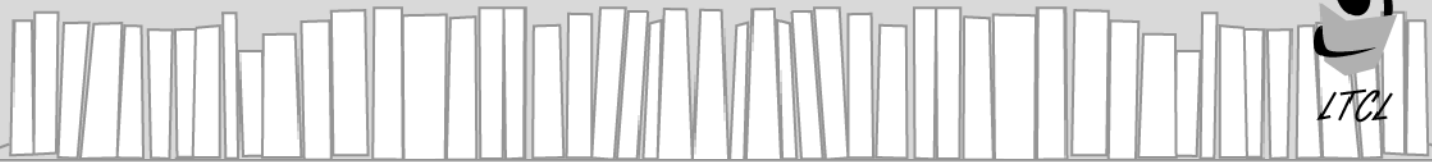

GROW ANYTHING IN A CONTAINER WITH MASTER GARDENER CANDIS CLARKE SUNDAY, JANUARY 23 @ 2 PM

Come to the library on Sunday, January 23rd at 2 PM to learn how to grow anything in a container from certified Master Gardener Candis Clarke. She will demonstrate how to plant vegetables, herbs, and succulents in various sizes and styles of containers. Clarke has been an organic gardener for over 30 years and has taught gardening to children for the past 10 years at private and public schools. She runs a backyard gardening program called Gardenheads that is available to children ages 4 to 8. "Teaching organic gardening to children is my passion," said Clarke.

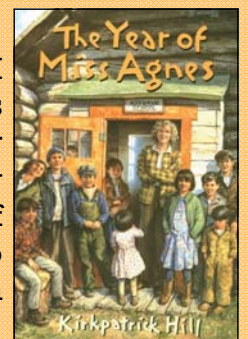


MOTHER/DAUGHTER BOOK CLUB SUNDAY, JANUARY 30 @ 2 PM

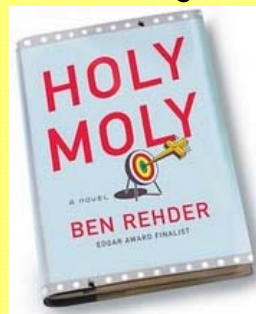

TUESDAY, JANUARY 18 @ 3:45 PM

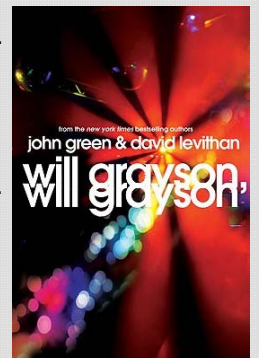

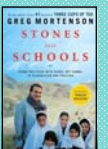
