OVERDRIVE VIRTUAL LIBRARY TRAINING SESSION THURSDAY, JUNE 9 @ 9 AM

Download audiobooks, eBooks, music, and video anytime, from anywhere - for free! Browse the collection, check out with your library card, and download to a PC, Mac, and many mobile devices. To get started, you will need to install free software. For audiobooks, music, and video, install OverDrive Media Console. For eBooks, you'll need Adobe Digital Editions. Titles can be enjoyed immediately or transferred to a variety of devices, including iPods, Sony Readers, Nooks, and many others. Some audio titles can also be burned to CD to listen to on-the-go. Titles will automatically expire at the end of the lending period. There are no late fees!

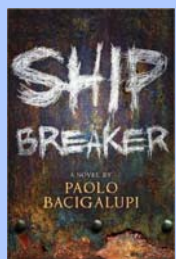
LIBRARY CAMP & LUNCH BUNCH

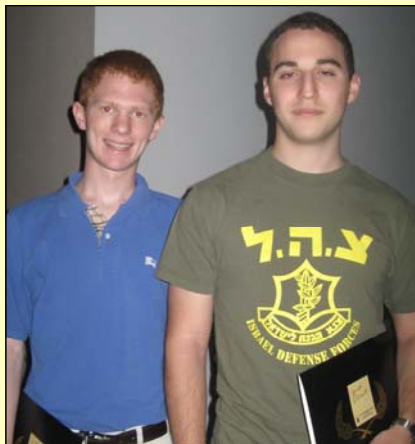
THANK YOU, LADIES OF CHARITY AND LAKE TRAVIS THRIFT SHOP!



The Friends Book Club will meet on Monday, June 6th to select future titles. The club meets at 10am at Lake Travis United Methodist Church (1502 RR 620 North).

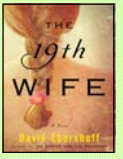
