CITY OF LAKEWAY ELECTION SATURDAY, MAY 14

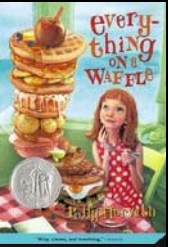

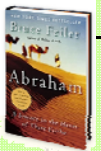

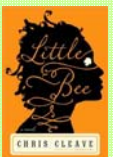
