





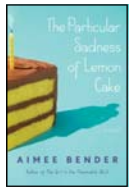
The Friends of the Library will meet on Thursday, January 19th at 9:30am in the library workroom. All are welcome to attend.

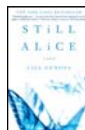
